

## **ADMISSIONS POLICY**

If applicants for admission to Haven High Technology College exceed the number of places available, the highest priority will be given to those for whom the college is clearly more appropriate than any other college. In allocating places in accordance with this policy the following factors will be considered:

- expressions of parental preference for schools;
  - medical reasons why the college is most suitable;
  - established family connection for instance:
- (a) a brother or sister already at the college, whether or not resident in the same household.
  - (b) Another child living in the same household where an adult living in the household has full parental responsibility
  - (c) In the case of twins, or brothers and sisters in the same year group, where there is only one place, both will be considered together as one application. (the college will be able to go above admissions for that one child.)

Children with Special Educational Needs will not be part of the over subscription criteria.

If any of the criteria above are oversubscribed, the final tie-break will be driving distance with the child living the nearest being offered the place. (distance is measured electronically by the Local Authority using post office address points of the home address and college.)
