

HAVEN HIGH TECHNOLOGY COLLEGE
UNIFORM POLICY

Haven High Technology College wishes to ensure that all students of Haven High wear a uniform that distinguishes college students as part of the learning environment. The college pledges to make the uniform easily obtainable and at affordable prices.

The uniform shall be as follows:

Black sweatshirt with the Haven High logo
White polo shirt with the Haven High logo
Black trousers/skirt
Black shoes

Prefects will wear grey sweatshirt and the Head girl; Head boy and deputies will wear a sweatshirt of a different colour, which may change each year.

Since 2002 the college has had a strict uniform code, especially with regard to the wearing of trainers. If students arrive to college without their full uniform, the pastoral team will do all it can to make arrangements for the student to attend classes as normal:

- A phone call home to try to arrange correct uniform to be brought in
- Borrowing a sweatshirt for the day
- Borrowing shoes (which have been specially purchased in various sizes and are disinfected in the same way that bowling shoes are disinfected)
- Borrowing black gym plimsolls

Failing any of the above, students will work in the pastoral area. Staff will be asked to send suitable work for students so as not to fall behind.

The college gives details of the uniform, which is sent to all, parents at the start of each year and is available at all times on the reverse of the college calendar.

Students are allowed to wear 1 signet ring, 1 watch and 1 pair of studs only.

Students should not have an extreme hairstyle.
